Sea Turtles #1

I Sea turtles lay their eggs on the beach. The female turtle comes out of the ocean and onto the beach. She digs a hole to lay her eggs and then returns to the sea. When the baby turtles hatch, they dig their way out of the hole and then crawl to the ocean. The trip across the beach can be

dangerous! Many animals come to the beach to eat the little, baby turtles as they crawl toward the water. After they reach the water, male sea turtles never return to land. Females return to lay their eggs.


Sea Turtles #2

I Sea turtles live in ocean waters. They have strong front flippers that help make them very good swimmers. They are also very fast in the water! Their heavy shells and flippers make them slow and clumsy on land though. Most sea turtles stay in the water, only going to the beach to lay their eggs.

2 The Ridley Sea Turtle is the smallest sea turtle. It grows to about two feet long. The Hawksbill or "tortoise-shell" turtle, has a beautiful shell and is a little larger than the Ridley. Other sea turtles are the Green Sea Turtle, the Loggerhead, and the Olive-Backed turtle.

3 The largest of the sea turtles is called the Leatherback Sea Turtle. It can weigh as much as a young elephant which is almost 1,500 pounds! From flipper to flipper, this huge turtle may measure 10 to 12 feet long. The Leatherback has a tough layer of smooth skin instead of a shell like the other sea turtles.
