Warm Weather Penguins

While most penguins are known to live in cold regions of the world, there are penguins that do live in warmer climates. The warmest area that a warm-climate penguin lives in is about 75 degrees Fahrenheit, which is much warmer than chilly Antarctica. When the penguins get too hot in the sun, they stand and hold out their arms in an effort to cool off. Two popular penguins that live in warmer weather are the African and Galapagos penguins.



Cold Weather Penguins

Most penguins live in very cold areas of the world. They have thick feathers that repel the cold water and keep their bodies warm. They also have a layer of fat on their bodies that keep them warm in freezing temperatures. During cold nights and days in the winter, penguins will huddle together in a huge group and keep warm just by being close to other penguins. They take turns being the cold penguins on the outside of the circle.
